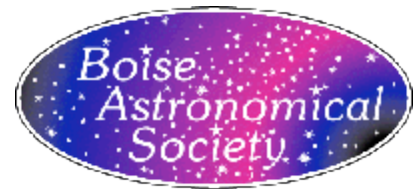
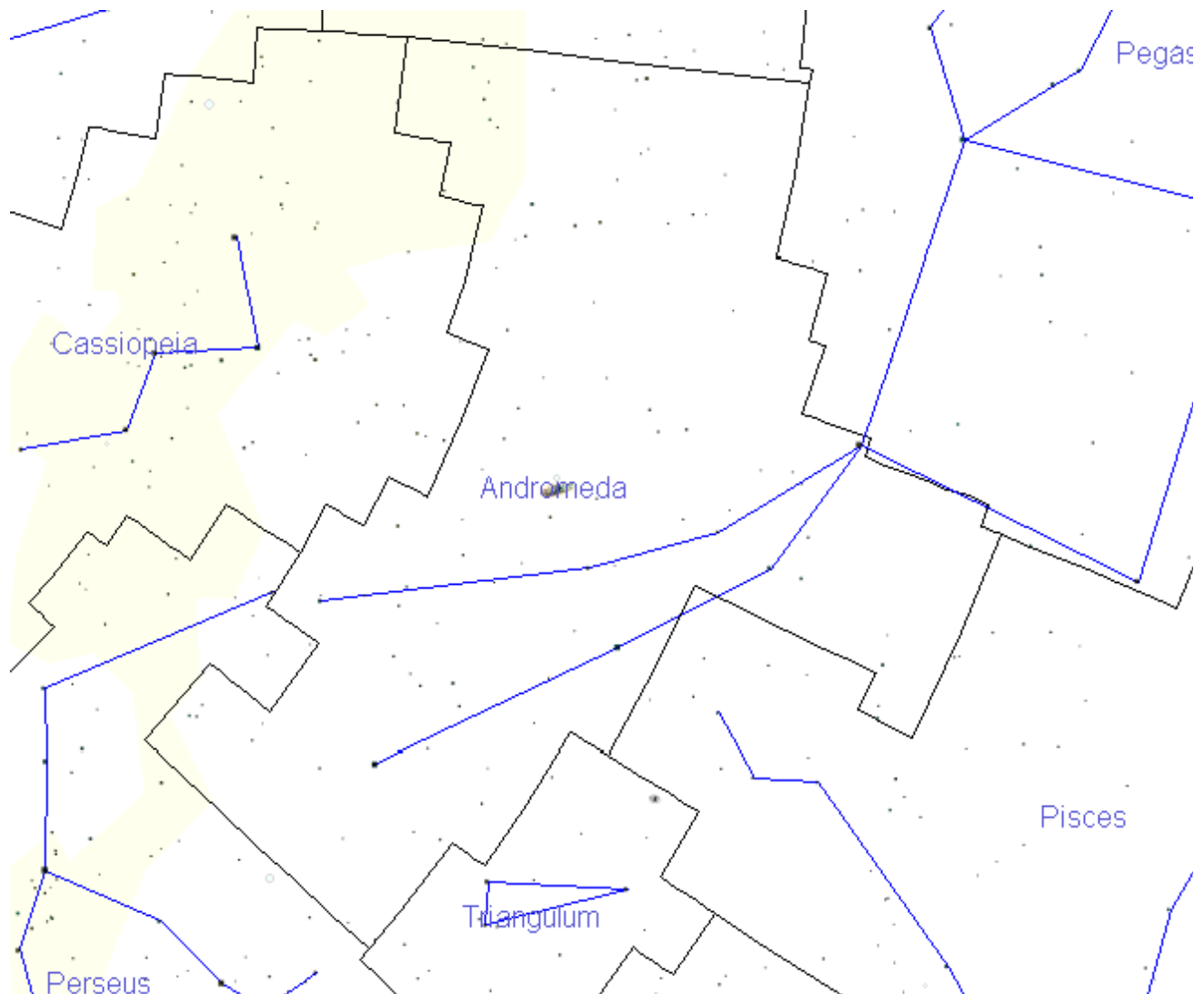


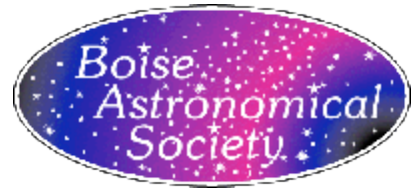
Andromeda

Andromeda, "The Chained Princess", is known more for the galaxy that resides within it than for any of the other stars. The constellation resides between Cassiopeia and Pegasus. It forms the shape of the letter A with a star at the tip also used to form the square in Pegasus. This star, α (Alpha) Andromeda, called Alpheratz or Sirrah, was at one time considered part of Pegasus but is part of Andromeda.
